



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) 2024

When is the Quiet Adventures Symposium?

On Saturday, March 2, 2024. Doors open at 9 am and close at 5:30 pm. Please no pets at this MSU facility.

Where will the Quiet Adventures Symposium be held?

The 2024 QAS will be held at the [MSU Livestock Pavilion located at 4301 Farm Lane](#), Lansing, Michigan on the south side of campus, between Forest and Mt. Hope Roads.

Where will I stay overnight when attending QAS?

QAS organizers have reserved a block of rooms at Candlewood Suites, 517-351-8181, at 3545 Forest Road. Exhibitors and attendees can book rooms at the Quiet Adventures rate (\$94 efficiency, \$124 one bedroom, plus tax, etc.) using the code QA2 until the block is filled. Use [this link](#) to book.

I bought my advanced ticket(s) online. What do I do now?

On QAS day, March 2, go to the Advanced Ticket Desk inside the entrance at the Pavilion. Bring everybody in your group listed for the advance tickets. The desk is located inside on your left, past the concessions counter. We'll ask the last name of the person who bought the tickets and then check the list of people included in your record. We'll give each of you a wrist band. **No ticket sales will take place at this desk.** So, if you want to add a person and it is before Feb 26, you should buy an Advance Ticket for them so that they do not have to wait in a Sales line.

On QAS day, can I use a credit card to pay for my ticket?

Yes. There will be two lines, one line for credit cards or cash and one line for cash only. Cash may be faster!

Do I have to pay for parking?

No, parking is free. If you're attending the QAS, please park in front of the Pavilion (north side, towards Mt Hope). If you're an exhibitor, park in the lot across Farm Lane east of the Pavilion. Very limited exhibitor parking is available south of the Pavilion. Overflow parking is across Mt Hope road in the MSU long term lots.

Can I buy food at the Pavilion?

Yes, the Pavilion concession stand will be open for food and drinks and will be staffed by MSU concessionaire. Food trucks were not an option for this event. There is seating near the Red Cedar River Room and in the arena bleachers.

Is there a station to refill my water bottle?

Yes. There is a filtered water bottle filler station between the bathrooms located near the Main Stage Auditorium. We encourage you to bring your own bottle and avoid single use bottles!

Will there be raffles?

Yes. We'll have two Grand Prize Raffles, one for Surf and one for Turf. They will be announced soon. There will also be door prizes with items generously donated by our speakers, exhibitors and others. More information soon. Check FACEBOOK! #QAS2024
